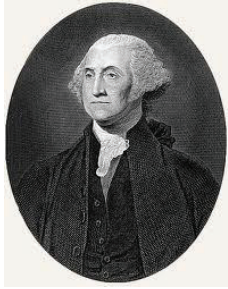


NAME YOUR FOUNDING FATHERS

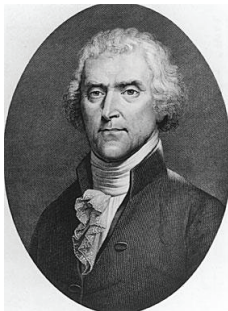

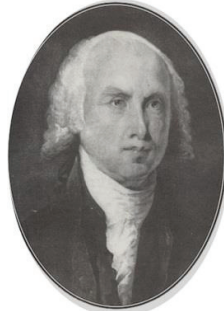
